## St. Edward School WISCONSIN SCHOOL CHOICE PROGRAM How to Qualify and How to Apply

#### What is the Wisconsin School Choice Program?

The state of Wisconsin has a program that allows eligible students to attend a participating private school in grades four-year-old kindergarten (4K) to 12. The private school, on behalf of the student's parent or guardian, receives a state aid payment for each eligible student.

#### How is a Family Eligible?

Student eligibility is based on a combination of student residency, income and age. Students must also be applying to certain grades or have metaprior year requirement.

#### What is the Residency Requirement?

All students must provide documentation that they live in the State of Wisconsin. Acceptable documentation includes utility bills, W2's, mortgages.

#### What is the Income Requirement?


New Choicestudents must provide income documentation showing that the family income does not exceed the income limits. Those limits for 2025-26 are:

One Person — \$33,132 Two People --- \$44,968 Three People -- \$56,804 Four People — \$68,640

Five People ---- \$80,476 Six People ---- \$92,312

(Add \$11,836 for each additional member)

#### What are the Age Requirements?

Students ages 4 through 20 on or before September 1 are eligible to apply for the Choice program. Additionally, a student must be at least the following age on or before September 1: 4 years old for 4K – 5 years old for 5K - 6 years old for Grade 1.

### The application period runs from February 3 - April 17, 2025

Current Choice Families are required to re-apply but will only need proof of residency.
